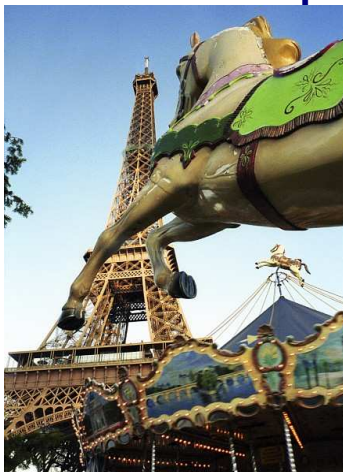

## Summer holiday in Paris Enjoy the festive air of the capital in summer



The merry-go-round at the Eiffel Tower

**Day 1:** Arrival in Paris late afternoon. Welcome by your guide at the airport or the train station and transfer to your hotel. Room allocation. Each participant receives a map of Paris and information about restaurant and current shows. **Welcome dinner** in a nearby restaurant.

**Day 2:** Morning guided tour of the **Louvre museum** with its **glass pyramid** created by the architect Ieoh Ming Pei. After lunch break time to admire the wonderful sculptures with the Marble "**Horses of Marly**" by Coustou in the Marly courtyard. Afternoon walking tour through the gardens of the **Palais Royal** and along the galleries around the gardens with the nearby **Comédie Française** and **Théâtre du Palais Royal**. More recently **Daniel Buren** installed a series of black-and-white striped columns at the south of the gardens. The rest of the day is at leisure.

**Day 3 :** Morning visit of the **Pompidou Centre** totally renovated for its entry in the year 2000. by architect Renzo Piano, Jean-François Bodin and Bredan Mac Farlane and housing the **National Museum of Modern Art**. Guided visit of the museum and free time to admire the wonderful panoramic view over Paris from the terrace on the 6<sup>th</sup> floor. Afternoon we catch the **Batobus** for a cruise along the river Seine. With 8 stops along the river Batobus invites to discover Paris in an original manner.

**Day 4:** Morning visit of the **Marine Museum**. Created in 1748, it is both the oldest and the richest Marine museum of the world with 1737 models of boats telling the history of the French marine since the 17<sup>th</sup> century. Lunch break to admire the wonderful sight on the **Eiffel Tower** facing the Trocadero terrace. Afternoon visit of the Eiffel Tower, symbol of Paris. An unforgettable moment which remains in memories of millions of visitors.

**Day 5:** Morning departure for the **Bois de Boulogne**, former Royal hunting domain until king Louis XVI opened it to the public. Visit of the **Bagatelle rose garden**, one of the first rose garden of the world. **Picnic lunch on the green**. Afternoon **rowing experience** on the lake of the Bois de Boulogne. To go back in time, it just needs to hire a row boat and row avoiding ducks and white swans up to the "**Chalet des Iles**" in the middle of the lake. This cottage was built by Napoleon III for the pleasure of the empress who came here to rest with friends and artists.

**Day 6:** Transfer to the airport or station
